CIAC welcomed measures put in place to ensure that Canada is a competitive environment for industry investment in the Government's 2018 Fall Economic Statement. We will continue to work with government to increase investments in advanced manufacturing such as chemistry, and to support regulatory modernization.





CIAC members set ambitious targets that **100 per cent** of plastics packaging would be **reusable**, **recyclable or recoverable by 2030**; and that **100 per cent** would be **re-used**, **recycled**, **or recovered by 2040**.

CIAC and its members support and have been actively engaged in the Canadian Council of Ministers of the Environment's Strategy and **Canada-Wide Action Plan on Zero Plastic Waste.**

CLIMATE CHANGE AND CANADA'S LOW-CARBON ADVANTAGE

While supporting carbon pricing, CIAC will work with government officials and policy makers on policy and regulatory approaches that maintain the **competitiveness of Canada's chemistry industry** and that recognize our low-carbon advantage.
