## ***Tracking and improving workplace health and safety performance***

Created in 1991 by the Chemistry Industry Association of Canada (CIAC), the Safety and Health Analysis Recognition and Exchange (SHARE) Network brings together the chemistry industry's occupational health and safety professionals to develop solutions and share their best-practices and expertise in tracking and improving workplace health and safety performance.

Through the Network, CIAC members and associate members participate in discussions, webinars and CIAC's biennial conference. They share a common goal of continuous improvement and the provision of the safest workplaces in the industry.

## ***Did you know?***

Since its creation, SHARE members have reduced the number of injuries and illnesses at their facilities by 86 per cent and the number of days away from work by 79 per cent.

At 32 per cent, the most commonly reported health and safety incident at SHARE-member facilities in 2015 was: strain, overexertion, over load, and stress.





## Safer facilities, and safer communities

SHARE members strive to ensure that their facilities are running safely. Many SHARE member-companies have safety programs in place that go beyond what is required by law or even their employee health and safety committees.

Members openly discuss the health and safety incidents that occur at their facilities and their solutions so that other members can take preventative action. They also share policies, fact sheets and lessons learned to help each other develop the best safety programs in the chemistry industry.
